

In 2022 we continued to offer a diverse bill of Jazz, Indie, Metal, Progressive, Jam, Improvisational, Classical, Punk, Ska, Country, Blues, Folk & more every Thursday through Sunday evening FOR FREE.

In addition, we hosted 29 bands in our indoor theater that not only exposed the artists to a global audience, but provided them with recorded audio and visual assets they can use to promote their music and continue to grow.





This year we presented 14 art exhibitions.
These curated shows maintained our mission and featured works by local, national, and international artists in thought provoking new perspectives on 2022.






















2022 Residency Program Included:

"PLIGHT" by The Choreo Joey Project dance show using jazz and West African dance to create new ballets with contemporary socio-political and historical context.

"Taken by Artificial Surprise" by Jeanette Andrews in an installation, exploring issues in Al and how surprise is uniquely human and crucial for consciousness.

"ISLANDERS" by Compound Playground, dance duo, Chieh Hsiung and Yu-Wei Hsiao, Taiwanese performance artists in NYC.

"NOTHING FURTHER" is **by Meridith Grundei** takes you on a generational whirlwind of a ride through the closed doors of a suburban home.

"Brothers in Arms" by Dominican-American and Scottish creators James Allen Clements and John Maria Gutierrez is a devised multi-disciplinary theater piece exploring isolation, survival, connection and intimacy between male-identifying folks.

"Unbreakable Hope and Resilience" by Migiwa Miyajima is a nine-movement musical suite played by a 17 piece jazz orchestra and a projection mapping highlighting the strength and resilience she witnessed in survivors of the 2011 Great East Japan Earthquake.

"Untitled Dream Musical" by Daniel Emond is the first half of a new musical exploring gender relationships within the office of Freud and Jung. A huge part of the Culture Lab LIC mission is to provide free space to other nonprofit organizations to further their missions. We support them with technical needs, community outreach, staffing, scheduling, tables, chairs, audio visual equipment, and most of all, keeping this amazing space available for their use!

Our **Fall Vendor Market** enjoyed its first year and featured new vendors every weekend highlighting local makers, businesses, and artisans! We will continue to provide opportunities for our communities commerce and connection in the years to come.
